
IT'S A BLUE WORLD-1ST VERSE(BAR) (COMMENTS BELOW)

- 1. Note that the first three chords are the ii, V, I of the key of the song.
- 2. This is just the first verse of the song, but an excellent exercise for many jazz chords, including the major and minor 9ths, dominant 9ths, major 7ths, dominant 7#5 and dominant 7b9.
- 3. If you are not familiar with the tune, please go to my Songs page, and click on "It's a Blue World."
- 4. The numbers at the top of the columns refer to the number of beats (quarter notes in this 4/4 song) that each chord is played.
- 5. I started with the key of F only because that's the key in which I prefer to sing the song.
